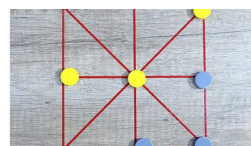
My Favorite Hobbies

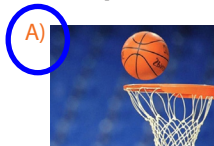

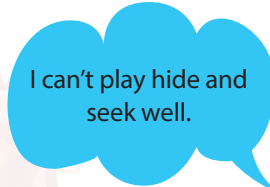

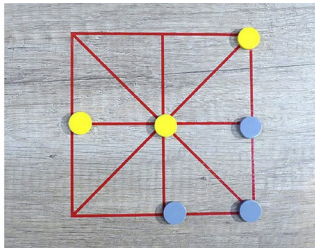
