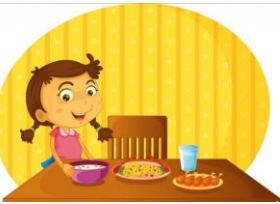

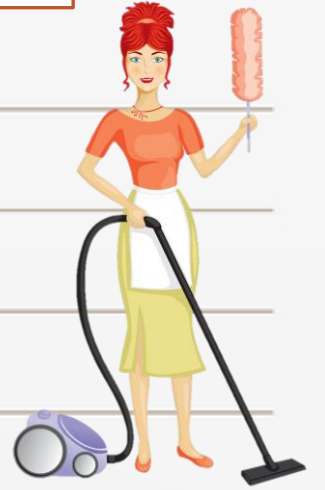

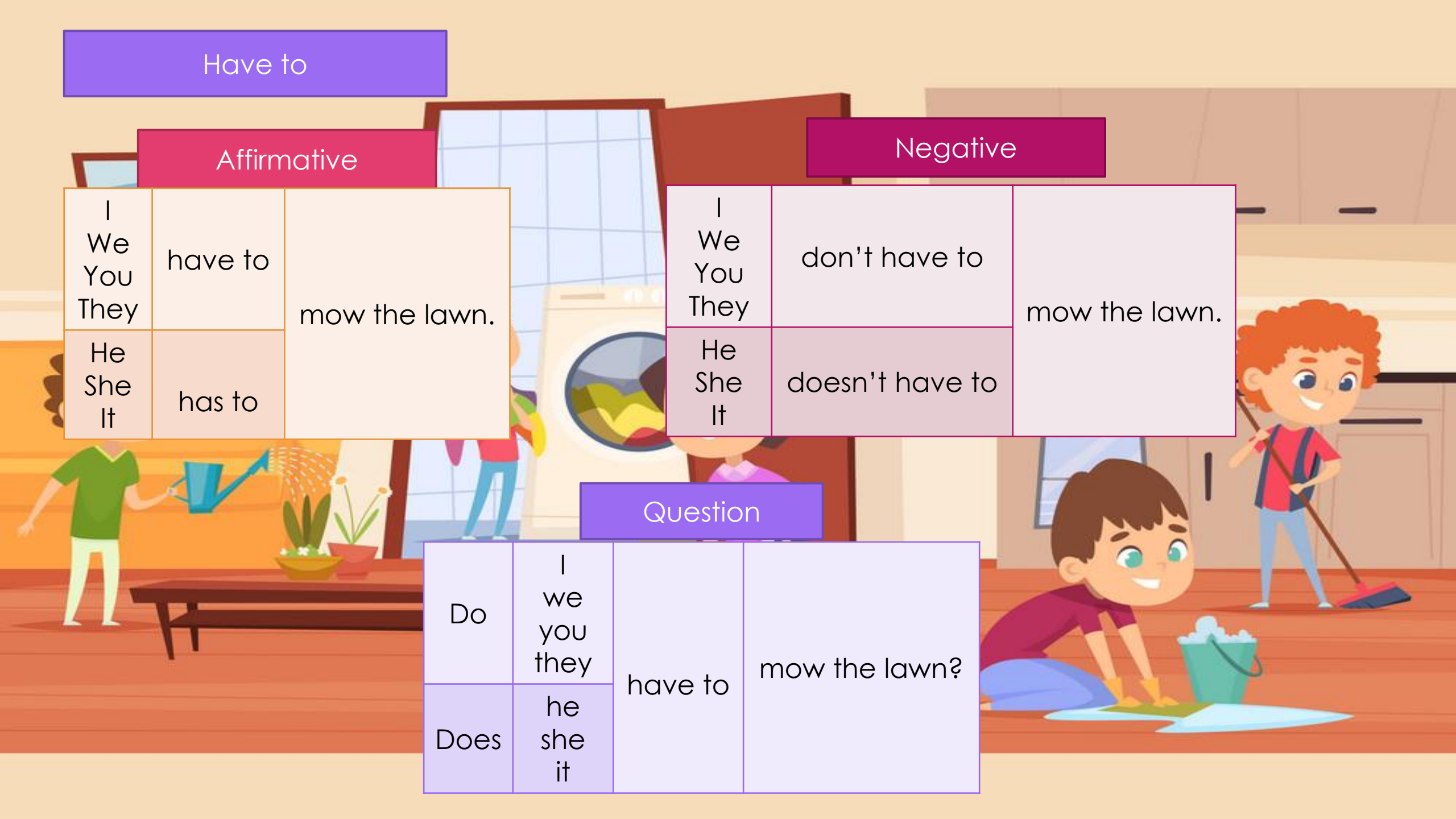

Expressing Responsibilities

If we have a responsibility, task or duty, we can use **'be responsible for'** or **'be in charge of'**.

Study the examples below.

I'm **responsible for** making my bed.

I'm **in charge of** making my bed.

She is **responsible for** doing the laundry.

She is **in charge of** doing the laundry.
