## Expressing Personal Opinions

We use **'think'** to expressing our ideas and personal opinions.

I / We / You / They **think** reality shows are funny.  
I / We / You / They **don't think** reality shows are funny.  
**Do** I / we / you / they **think** reality shows are funny?  
He / She / It **thinks** sitcoms are amusing.  
He / She / It **doesn't think** sitcoms are amusing.  
**Does** he / she / it **think** sitcoms are amusing?

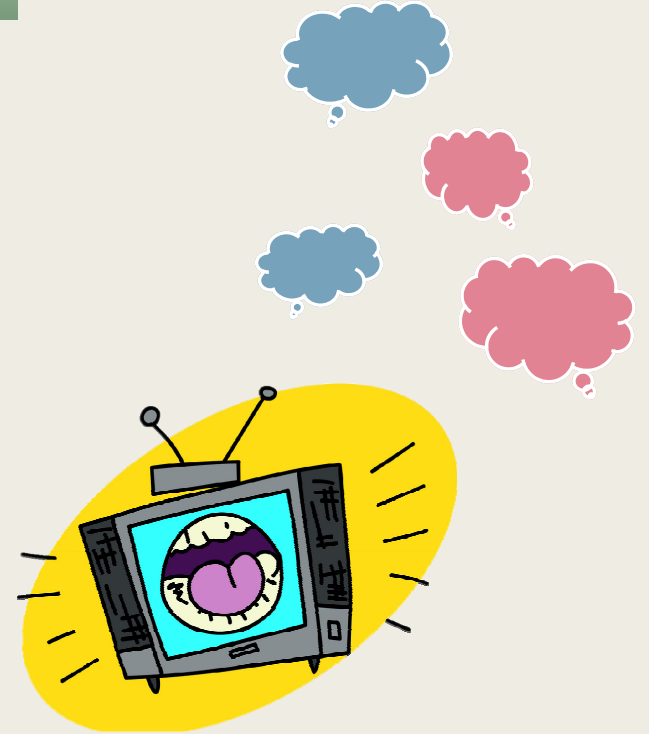

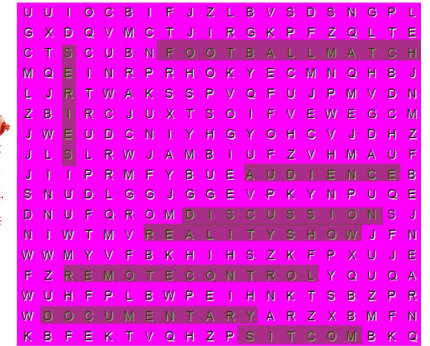

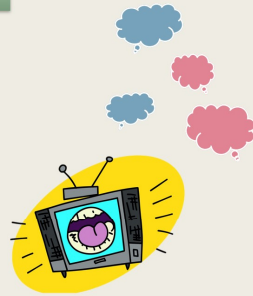
