Comparative Adjectives

- We use comparative adjectives to compare things.
- We use “**than**” in sentences to make a comparison.
- Study the rules below.

For adjectives with one syllable : -er	dull cold young	duller colder younger
For adjectives with two or more than two syllables: more	horrible exciting boring	more horrible more exciting more exciting
For adjectives ending in -y : -ier	crazy noisy funny	crazier noisier funnier
There aren't any rules for irregular adjectives.	good bad far	better worse farther / further



Examples

- Carrouseles are more boring than bumper cars. → Atlı karıncalar çarpışan arabalardan daha sıkıcıdır.
- Shopping malls are noisier than markets. → Alışveriş merkezleri marketlerden daha gürültülüdür.
- This place is better than a park. → Bu yer bir parktan daha iyi.
- Roller coasters are crazier than Ferris wheels. → Hız trenleri dönme dolaplardan daha çılgıncadır.
- Ghost trains are duller than Ferris wheels. → Korku trenleri dönme dolaplardan daha sıkıcıdır.

Likes & Dislikes

We can use 'like, dislike, love, enjoy' and 'hate' to express likes and dislikes.

Positive	Negative	Question
I / We / You / They like carnivals. He / She / It likes carnivals.	I / We / You / They don't like carnivals. He / She / It doesn't like carnivals.	Do I / we / you / they like carnivals? Does he / she / it like carnivals?

Short Answers

- Yes, I / we / you / they **do**. No, I / we / you / they **don't**.
Yes, he / she / it **does**. No, he / she / it **doesn't**.

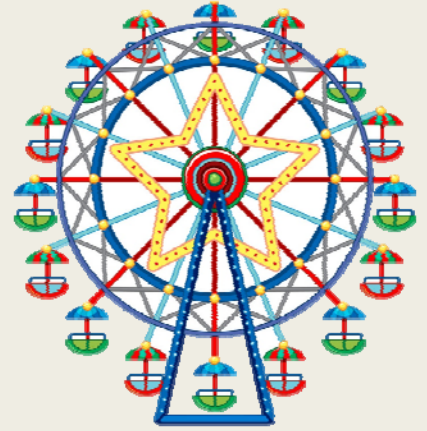

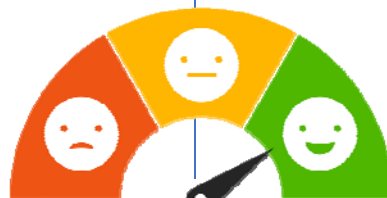
